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Adoption guidelines for small mammals

By applying for one of our animals, you agree to the following as part of the application process:

1. Provide truthful and accurate information, provide most up to date information regarding current pets, past pets, and living situations.
2. Understand that small mammals (rabbits, hamsters, guinea pigs, rats, etc) may require veterinary care; including but not limited to annual wellness exams, preventative care/illness/injuries, dental issues etc. They can be both a financial and emotional commitment, just like a pet dog or cat.
3. A video/zoom call will be required for pre-adoption approval. Once approved for a specific pet, you must submit images/videos of what type of housing/husbandry you will provide for your new pet before you are fully approved for a particular pet. If you need housing/husbandry/diet recommendations, please ask!
4. Understand that Small N Furry Rescue is not liable for any damages/financial responsibility once a pet is adopted. If you must rehome your adopted pet for any reason, the rescue must be notified, and has the right to assist in the rehoming process or will take the pet back into the rescue organization.
5. Agree that your adopted small pet will be kept INDOORS only and will not be left alone unsupervised.
6. An adoption donation will be suggested at the time of adoption. This amount is dependent on the species of animal you are adopting and the medical treatment that was performed while the pet was in rescue.
